Paracetamol, Guaifenesin, Phenylephrine Hydrochloride

#### Please read right through this leaflet before you start using this medicine.

This medicine is available without prescription but you still need to use Haleon Cold and Flu Nurse All in One Capsules carefully to get the best results from them.

- If you have any questions or if there is anything you do not understand ask your pharmacist.

- 1. What Haleon Cold and Flu Nurse All in One Capsules are and what they are used for

Haleon Cold and Flu Nurse All in One Capsules are used for the relief of the symptoms of colds and flu and the pain and congestion of sinusitis. including aches and pains, headache, blocked nose and sore throat, chills and feverishness. They can also loosen stubborn mucus (phlegm) and provide relief from chesty coughs.

This medicine contains three active ingredients. Paracetamol is a painkiller and reduces your temperature when you have a fever. Guaifenesin is an expectorant which loosens phlegm and relieves a chesty cough. Phenylephrine hydrochloride is a decongestant which unblocks your nose and sinuses helping you breathe more easily.

2. What you need to know before you take Haleon Cold and Flu Nurse All in One Capsules



Do not take Haleon Cold and Flu Nurse All in One Capsules

• if you have ever had an allergic reaction to paracetamol, guaifenesin, phenylephrine

hydrochloride or to any of the other inaredients (listed in section 6)

- if you have kidney or liver problems (including alcoholic liver disease), overactive thyroid, diabetes, high blood pressure or heart disease
- if you have phaeochromocvtoma or glaucoma
- if you are taking tricyclic antidepressants or if you are taking or if you have taken in the last two weeks monoamine oxidase inhibitors (MAOIs) (e.g. moclobernide) prescribed for **depression**
- if you are taking **beta-blockers** (e.g. atenolol)
- if you have an **enlarged prostate**

### Contains paracetamol.

Taking too much paracetamol can cause serious harm to your liver. Do not take anything else containing paracetamol while taking this medicine. Do not take with any other flu. cold. decongestant products or cough suppressants.

Take special care with Haleon Cold and Flu Nurse All in One Capsules.

This product may cause dizziness. If affected do not drive or operate machinery.

Ask your doctor before you take this medicine:

- if you have **blood vessel disease** such as Raynaud's phenomenon
- if you have asthma or chronic cough
- if you have liver or kidney problems • if you have a severe infection as this may
- increase the risk of metabolic acidosis. Signs of metabolic acidosis include:
- deep, rapid, difficult breathing
- feeling sick (nausea), being sick (vomiting) loss of appetite

Contact a doctor immediately if you get a combination of these symptoms.

# If you are taking other medicines

Talk to your doctor or pharmacist before taking Haleon Cold and Flu Nurse All in One Capsules if you are taking any prescribed medicines; particularly metoclopramide or domperidone (for nausea [feeling sick] or vomiting [being sick]), or **ergotamine** or **methylsergide** (for migraine), or colestyramine (to lower **blood cholesterol**) or drugs to lower **blood** pressure; appetite suppressants or stimulants; drugs to treat **depression** such as **tricyclic** antidepressants (e.g. amitriptyline) or heart disease (e.g. digoxin) or if you take blood thinning drugs (anticoagulants e.g. warfarin).

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- **Tell your doctor** if you get them:
- Raised blood pressure, headache, dizziness, difficulty sleeping, nervousness, anxiety, diarrhoea or sickness.

If you get any side effects, talk to your doctor, pharmacist or nurse. This includes any possible side effects not listed in this leaflet.

#### 5. How to store Haleon Cold and Flu Nurse All in One Capsules

Keep out of the sight and reach of children. Do not use this medicine after the 'EXP' date shown on the pack. Do not store above 25°C.

#### 6. Contents of the pack and other information

Active ingredients Each capsule contains Paracetamol 500 mg, Guaifenesin 100 mg and Phenylephrine Hydrochloride 6.1 mg. Other ingredients Maize starch, croscarmellose sodium, sodium laurilsulfate,

magnesium stearate and talc. The capsule shell is made of gelatin and contains the colours quinoline yellow (E 104), indigo carmine (E 132), erythrosine

(E 127) and titanium dioxide (E 171).

Pack sizes of 8, 16 and 24 capsules are available Not all pack sizes may be marketed.
