

This medicine contains:

- Propylene glycol (E1520), 4.7mg per 5ml dose.
- Sodium benzoate (E211), 10mg per 5ml dose. Less than 1mmol sodium (23mg) per 5ml dose, that is to say essentially "sodium-free"

3. HOW TO GIVE TIXYLIX CHILDREN'S DRY & TICKLY COUGH 15%V/V SYRUP Always give Tixylix Children's Dry & Tickly Cough 15%v/v Syrup exactly as your doctor has told you. You

should check with your doctor or pharmacist if you are not sure. Using the measuring spoon provided, the following doses may be given 3 to 4 times daily, by mouth, as required. Allow 3 to 4 hours between doses.

Age	Dose
Under 3 months	Do not give Tixylix Children's Dry & Tickly Cough 15%v/v Syrup
3 to 12 months	One 5 ml spoonful
1 to 5 years	Two 5 ml spoonfuls

After use, wipe the neck of the bottle clean and make sure the safety cap is properly closed. You can help by keeping your child warm and giving plenty of fluids. Make sure the bedroom is well ventilated but not cold. If your child's condition does not get better in 3 days, talk to your doctor.

If you give more Tixylix Children's Dry & Tickly Cough 15%/v Syrup than you should Giving your child too much Tixylix Children's Dry & Tickly Cough 15%/v Syrup may cause diarrhoea. If you have accidentally given your child more medicine than you should, or if you suspect that your child has taken extra medicine, please contact your doctor. Take along the bottle and the label, and any medicine that is left. If you forget to give Tixylix Children's Dry & Tickly Cough 15%v/v Syrup

Do not give your child a double dose to make up for a forgotten dose.

If you have any further questions on the use of this product, ask your doctor or pharmacist.

4. POSSIBLE SIDE EFFECTS

Like all medicines, Tixylix Children's Dry & Tickly Cough 15%v/v Syrup can cause side effects, although not everybody gets them.

Tixylix Children's Dry & Tickly Cough 15%v/v Syrup may cause diarrhoea in overdose. Reporting of side effects

If you get any side effects, talk to your doctor or nurse. This includes any possible side effects not listed in this leaflet. 5. HOW TO STORE TIXYLIX CHILDREN'S DRY & TICKLY COUGH 15%V/V SYRUP

Keep out of the reach and sight of children.

Do not store above 25°C. Keep the container tightly closed.

Do not use Tixylix Children's Dry & Tickly Cough 15%v/v Syrup after the expiry date which is stated on the carton and the bottle label after <EXP>

The expiry date refers to the last day of that month.

Medicines should not be disposed of via wastewater or household waste. Ask your pharmacist how to dispose of medicines no longer required. These measures will help to protect the environment.

What Tixylix Children's Dry & Tickly Cough 15%v/v Syrup contains

- The active substance is glycerol (0.75 ml per 5ml dose). The other ingredients are liquid maltitol (Lycasin) (E965), hydroxyethyl cellulose (E1525), sodium benzoate (E211), citric acid monohydrate (E330), sodium citrate (E331), lemon flavour (contains propylene glycol

E1520), honey flavour (contains propylene glycol E1520), purified water. What Tixylix Children's Dry & Tickly Cough 15%v/v Syrup looks like and contents of the pack Tixylix Children's Dry & Tickly Cough 15%v/v Syrup is a colour-free syrup. The following pack sizes are available:
